INTRODUCTION

This report covers the varieties of activities of the Centre in her engagement with secondary school students at the headquarters and state offices in 2023. Productivity Coaching and Mentoring in Schools is a programme that metamorphosed from the former Productivity-In-Action (PIA) Schools Programme with obvious improvement in the areas of participation and engagement. PCM is one of the key drivers of the Productivity Awareness Campaign of the Centre that kicked off since 2007. Also associated with PCM is the Productivity Youth Initiative Programme (PYIP) of the Centre.

In taking the message of Productivity to schools in Nigeria, the Centre strongly believes that the young minds can catch the ideals and practices of Productivity early in life which will in turn help them to perform better in all areas of life. It is also hoped that they will become Productivity champions, which will enable them spearhead Productivity initiatives in the next generation.

RATIONALE:

Productivity Coaching and Mentoring is an Awareness Campaign programme aimed at expanding the frontiers of productivity at the grassroots. It is an arm of the Productivity Awareness Campaign programme designed to take Productivity Awareness to secondary schools.

The Program is designed to drive Productivity awareness campaign to the secondary school students and to also introduce them to basic Productivity improvement tools and techniques and guide them on how to use them to improve their productivity. By this Programme, the Centre intend to instil Positive productivity culture, clear improvement perspectives, as well as the concepts and application of Productivity improvement initiatives that will enable students effectively improve their academics.

The Productivity Coaching and Mentoring Program is in two phases. The first phase is divided into three components, (a) Productivity lecture for students, (b) Formation of Productivity Clubs (c) Follow up – Coaching and Mentoring of club members. While the second phase include the debate, quiz, spelling bees and other mentoring and coaching activities.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE

The main objective of the Program is to make the youth imbibe productivity Culture early in life. The program also aims to instil in our youth positive attributes of hard work, creativity, honesty and self Reliance early in life and to catch them young in

their Productivity endeavours.

OTHER OBJECTIVES:

- Coach students on some basic productivity concepts, Improvement tools and techniques that would enhance their academic performance.
- Inculcate in them productivity values and culture.
- Establish Productivity clubs in the schools.
- Showcase the success of productivity activities in schools which could open up sponsorship opportunities for both the individual and the school.
- To assemble a group, that will be in the vanguard of championing productivity movement at an early stage in life.
- To have a club that would serve as a basis for spreading productivity messages.
- To create an avenue where the youths are mentored and coached on issues of Productivity.

METHODOLOGY

- I. Delivery of interactive productivity lectures.
- II. Installation of Productivity club.
- III. Monitoring of Productivity clubs.
- IV. Inter-Schools debate, quiz, spelling bees and other healthy competitions that can foster Productivity knowledge.

IMPACT

At the end of the Program, it is expected that;

- Students would be able to contribute productively to the society.
- Students would be fully informed and enlightened with full knowledge of the meaning and implication of Productivity.
- The transfer of knowledge of basic Productivity tools and techniques
- Productivity Culture becomes an integral part of the Nigerian Youths through the mentoring and coaching program.


